

CURRENT IMMUNIZATION RECORDS ARE REQUIRED
FOR ALL STUDENTS

6th & 7th Graders: Please email an updated copy of your student's immunization records (or your annual religious exemption) to office@headwatersacademy.org or fax to 406-585-9992.

7th Graders: Please note: proof of your 7th grade Tdap booster (or dr. signed & notarized religious or medical exemption) is required before the first day of school. Please schedule dr. appointments with this in mind.

* If record of these immunizations/exemption is not received by the first day of school, your child will not be allowed to attend HWA classes. *

All Students: A SPORTS PHYSICAL IS REQUIRED each year for ALL Headwaters Academy students to participate in Outdoor Education trips and the week-long Field Study Tour (FST) in the spring. A completed sports physical must be returned to HWA by August 31.

HEADWATERS ACADEMY IMMUNIZATION POLICY:

In the interest of keeping all Headwaters Academy community members safe and healthy HWA follows Montana law regarding the immunization of enrolled students.

1. Students must be up to date on all required vaccines at the time of entry into the school year.
2. Students with incomplete immunization records may attend school after submitting a "Montana Child Care and School Conditional Attendance Form" (form HES 103) completed by their physician.
3. Students with a medical exemption from immunization may attend school after submitting a "Medical Exemption Record." (form HES 101A)
4. Students with a religious exemption from immunization may attend school after submitting an "Affidavit of Exemption on Religious Grounds from Montana School immunization Law and Rules." (form HES 113) A new affidavit of exemption must be signed, sworn to, and notarized yearly and kept with the school's records.
5. In the event of an outbreak of a vaccine preventable disease in our

community, Headwaters Academy will follow Montana law and the Montana Department of Health requirements regarding notification to the Montana Department of Health and exclusion of unvaccinated students.
